The Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme, through the Global Climate Change Alliance Plus (GCCA+) Scaling Up Pacific Adaptation (SUPA) Project will convene its **Joint Virtual Session with GCCA+ SUPA countries on the 26th of June 2020** from 12:00 - 1:30pm (Samoa Time).

The GCCA+ SUPA Project aims to enhance climate change adaptation and resilience within ten Pacific Island countries. A key output for SPREP: climate and disaster risk information, knowledge management, monitoring and strategic planning capacities strengthened at national and regional levels.

Further from initial one-to-one calls, the objectives of this 1.5hour joint virtual session are:

- Share the results of online survey 'Scaling Up Adaptation in the Pacific Call' and level of interest with the use of existing data portals and information needs of potential users.
- Set and agree on the rationale and selection criteria for the three countries to trial.
- Review the indicators listing towards an impact analysis of climate change adaptation methodology.
