SUBJECT: **Launch of the first Pacific Climate Change Centre Open-Learning program under the PCCC e-Learning Platform. First Program: “Climate Change Adaptation and Disaster Risk Reduction through structural approaches”**

I am pleased to inform you that the Pacific Climate Change Centre (PCCC) launches their first Open-Learning program under the PCCC Project for Capacity Building on Climate Resilience in the Pacific (CBCRP-PCCC). The Open-Learning program is designed primarily for entry-level to mid-level practitioners from governments and non-government institutions including the private sector and is open through self-registration on the PCCC e-Learning Platform. The Open-Learning Program is in contrast to the Executive Courses which are designed only for nominated officials from the Pacific.

The first Open-Learning program on “Climate Change Adaptation and Disaster Risk Reduction through structural approaches” is now available on the PCCC e-Learning Platform: <https://spreptraining.moodlecloud.com>. This Open-Learning course was developed based on the previous executive course delivered in March 2021 with updated information on the IPCC 6th Assessment Report.
