Dear Focal Points,

I am pleased to announce that nominations are being accepted for the sixth regional training on “Ecosystem-based Adaptation and Mitigation”. The training will be held from 23 June – 28 July 2021 through the e-learning platform hosted by the Pacific Climate Change Centre (PCCC) in Apia, Samoa. This training is made possible through the Project for Capacity Building on Climate Resilience in the Pacific (CBCRP-PCCC) in partnership with JICA, and the Government of Samoa.

The training program aims to:

- Enhance understanding of climate risk, vulnerability of ecosystems to impacts of climate change and key issues and considerations to assessment methodologies, design, implement and scale up ecosystem-based approaches for climate resilience; and
- Develop skills to prepare problem and objective trees and logical frameworks to contribute project development.

We welcome a maximum of eight (8) participants per country. It is expected that government officials and practitioners from non-government institutions including the private sector who are working in the unit of ecosystem management and climate change, will join this training program. We encourage gender diversity and kindly request that the nomination is gender- balanced, where possible.
