The Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP), in partnership with the IMPACT Project would like to invite you or your representative(s) to the Pacific NAP Guidelines consultative workshop which will be held on the 1st of February 2022.

The Secretariat is working with Tonkin and Taylor International Limited, the consultant engaged under the IMPACT Project to develop the draft guidelines informed by a review of existing guidelines, tools and resources that the Pacific countries are currently using to guide adaptation planning at national, provincial and local levels and the development of National Adaptation Plans.
