CONTEXT FOR THE WORKSHOP

The first consultative workshop on the draft Pacific NAP Guideline was held on 1st of February 2022 and was attended by National Climate Change Focal Points representatives from nine Pacific Small Islands Developing States. A total of 32 participations from PSIDS and partner organisations attended the workshop.

The first part of the workshop involved a presentation on the draft Pacific National Adaptation Plan (NAP) Guideline, with each step of the adaptation planning process presented. A number of key issues were raised during the workshop in relation to the content and focus of the guideline. Discussion mainly focused on the challenges to the implementation of adaptation planning process and NAPs, as well as enabling activities which can be undertaken throughout the NAP process. The consultancy team is now working on addressing these issues in the next iteration of the guideline, which will be presented for discussion at the final consultative workshop scheduled to be held on 22 of February 2022.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP:

The objectives of the workshop are:

1. Present the changes to the draft Pacific NAP Guideline based on the comments from the first workshop and comments received via email from PSIDs and partner organisations; and
2. Discuss the way forward, including the application and use of the Pacific NAP Guideline to guide national adaptation planning.
