I am pleased to invite you to attend the webinar on the *“Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) Sixth Assessment Report: An overview of Impacts, Adaptation and Vulnerability”* for the Pacific, 10 March 2022. The webinar will be hosted by the Pacific Climate Change Centre in partnership with the Institute for Climate, Energy & Disaster Solutions at the Australian National University. The webinar will discuss the main findings of the report and its implications for the Pacific.

In February 2022, the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) will release its new Working Group II report which assesses the impacts, adaptation and vulnerabilities related to climate change. The report also presents options for creating a sustainable future for all through an equitable and integrated approach to mitigation and adaptation efforts at all scales. IPCC reports are the world’s most authoritative sources of climate science, approved by 195 countries.
