Dear Focal Points,

I am pleased to announce that nominations are being accepted for the Regional Training Stage 2 on “Strengthening Public and Private Collaboration to address Climate Change”. This training will be delivered in dual mode (*online and in person*) as part of the PCCC JICA Project for Innovative Solutions for the Pacific Climate Change Resilience (ISPCCR). The training will be held from 1-30 September 2025 through the PCCC e-learning platform and in-person at the PCCC in Apia, Samoa.

This training program aims to:

- Strengthen participants' knowledge of the potential and benefits of public-private collaboration for climate change project including learning about the methods and cases on public and private collaboration,
- Enhance understanding of innovative climate change adaptation and mitigation options for some of the key sectors,
- Enhance knowledge and skills on project management necessary for the formulation, implementation, and operation of climate change project, and
- Obtain skills for formulating climate change projects through public-private collaboration.

We welcome up to five (5) nominations per country from government entities. While online participation is welcomed free of charge, **please note that all costs related to in-person participation in Apia, Samoa are kindly expected to be covered by participant’s affiliated organization.**
