Subject: Request for tenders (RFT): Loss and Damage Consultant for the Development of a National Loss and Damage Evidence Base for the Solomon Islands under the Loss and Damage Capacity and Capability Project

Question 1:

In point 7 of the associated Terms of Reference, it is stated that the assignment will last a total of 60 days from the effective date. We would be grateful if you could clarify whether this refers to a continuous two-month period, or if the 60 working days may be distributed over a longer timeframe (e.g., across five months).

Response:

The 60 days may be distributed over a longer timeframe with reason, however the assignment will run alongside similar roles in a few other countries and will need to keep pace where possible.

Question 2:

I gather that the scope of work is geographically limited to the Solomon Islands, and that there may be parallel work in other Pacific countries. There is reference to a regional dialogue, youth dialogue, and technical support for a working group. Should this additional work be costed within the tender for the Solomon Islands.
