**Subject: Request for tenders: Loss and Damage Consultant for the Development of a National Loss and Damage Evidence Base for the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) under the Loss and Damage Capacity and Capability Project**

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**Question 1:**

Is there a projected start date envisioned by SPREP?

**Response:**

The start date will depend on a few factors. There is no set date, preferably the consultant will be available to start immediately after contract signing.

**Question 2:**

What scope of activities are expected by SPREP for the working week in Pohnpei? Are there any specific expectations or a predetermined schedule we should align with?

**Response:**

There is no predetermined schedule. This will need to be discussed with the climate change focal point in FSM. The expectations will be that the consultant speaks to a variety of relevant sources (ministries, NGOs, CSOs, communities) to gather data on L&D. The data collected will need to include 1. Existing reports and data that can be linked to L&D; and 2. Primary data (mixture of qualitative and quantitative) from a variety of sources that includes community members and GEDSI representatives.
